



Mathematics

The children will start the term by exploring the concept of time. They will be learning about units of time, how to find durations and will be telling the time to the nearest 5 minutes. They will then move onto properties of shape and will be exploring angles, types of line and describing and recognising 2D and 3D shapes. Finally, they will finish the term by learning about mass and capacity.

English

The children will start the term by learning all about the poetry of Benjamin Zephaniah and will then create their own recipe poems.

The children will then move onto exploring the life of the British monarchy. We will start off with a 'Cold Write' where children will have to think of a perfect day fit for the Queen. We will then focus on creative, fiction writing where children will apply their knowledge of the features of the different genres of writing we have explored this year.

Create

This term we will be exploring The Monarchy as our topic, we will look back at past Kings and Queens and their roles. We will explore Elizabethan fashion and design our own quizzes to support our recall of knowledge.

This topic has been especially selected for our children to extend their knowledge of The Royal Family, following the recent Jubilee celebrations.

Computing and PE

Children will understand some elements of survey design, some ethical and legal aspects of online data collection and use the Internet to facilitate data collection. They will gain skills in using charts to analyse data and gain skills in interpreting results.

Children will be applying and developing their fielding and batting skills learnt in rounders last term in this term's cricket lessons. We are very lucky this term to have a Cricketer from NCC to teach the children cricket alongside their teachers.

Science

The children will become builders this term. They will be exploring the properties of materials that are used to build structures, both manmade and in nature. There will be lots of practical investigations with an emphasis on working scientifically. The children will finish the topic by using all their learning to build a big structure so any newspaper or cardboard that could be brought in would be gratefully received.

Brainboost and Wow week

Linking to our previous English topic 'What did the tree see?' The children will be making artwork with recycled materials called 'what **did** the Queen see?' and 'What **will** the Queen see?'

The royal theme will be continued in WOW week as the children learn all about the different fashion eras the Queen has experienced and design their own creations.

Curriculum enrichment

This term we will be holding our Careers Day event inspiring our children about their future in the world of work.

We will also be holding our Sports Day which you will receive further information about later in the term.

RE and PSHE

In RE this term, we will be continuing our learning about peace and considering how religion can help to encourage peace in communities.

In PSHE the children will be learning about healthy diet and exercise including controlling sugar in our diets.
