Re: Vacancy for Fixed Term Full time teacher at Mawsley C.P School.

Thank you for requesting an application pack for the post of Teacher at Mawsley Primary School. The post is a full-time post with a start date of 1st September 2026. It is temporary post due to the expected falling role at the school. This post will be paid on the Teachers Main Scale, points 1 to 6.

The teacher appointed will work in collaboration with the other teachers in the year group to plan and deliver creative and motivating learning experiences to ensure progress. The teacher will work in partnership with other colleagues to develop a high quality learning environment for our children who are enthusiastic learners and love coming to school. We are looking for a teacher who is committed to working hard and making a difference to the progress of all the children in their class and wants to add to the life of our vibrant and enthusiastic learning community.

Our school opened in September 2004 with four classes and 87 children on roll. It was originally built to accommodate 210 children in seven classrooms. We currently have 277 children on roll with one mainstream reception class, two mixed year 1 and 2 classes, two mixed year 3 and 4 classes and three mixed year 5 and 6 classes. In September 2023, we opened our first class within the specialist provision with capacity for 9 children, a further expansion in 2024 enable us to support 27 pupils, and our final phase - completed this September – now allows us to offer high quality provision for 36 children.

Our staff are proud to work at Mawsley and are a close knit team who support and look after each. Below are some of the comments shared by parents when we undertook a recent parent questionnaire:

Comments were overwhelmingly linked to our staff team, their positivity, caring nature and approachability. Comments in response to the question: 'What do you like most about the school?'

The teachers, communication and offer of extra support.
